

**NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF
HEARING ON PROPOSED
CUMULATIVE IMPROVEMENT FUND**

Notice is hereby given the taxpayers of the Indian Boundary Conservancy District, located in Westchester Township, Porter County, Indiana, that the Board of Directors will meet at the Baugher Center at 100 W. Indiana Ave., in Chesterton, Porter County, Indiana at 7:00 p.m. on the 13th day of March, 2018, to consider the establishment of a cumulative improvement fund under the provisions of Indiana Code Section 14-33-21 for the purpose as follows:

For all uses as set out in IC 14-33-21-2

The tax will be levied on all taxable, real and personal property within the taxing district and will not exceed \$0.0333 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation. The proposed fund will be levied beginning with taxes due and payable in the year 2019. Taxpayers appearing at such hearing shall have the right to be heard thereon. The proposal for establishment of the cumulative improvement fund is subject to approval by the Department of Local Government Finance. Within 30 days after the date of the adoption of the cumulative improvement fund by the Board of Directors, the Indian Boundary Conservancy District will publish a notice of adoption. Upon publication of the notice of adoption, ten or more taxpayers in the taxing district may file a petition with the County Auditor not later than noon thirty (30) days after publication of the notice of adoption, setting forth their objections to the proposed fund.
