

NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS  
OF HEARING ON PROPOSED  
RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF A  
CUMULATIVE FIRE FUND

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of Pleasant Township, Porter County, Indiana that the Pleasant Township Trustee Board will consider at 205 S. Maple St. Kouts, at 5:15 pm on April 1, 2019, the re-establishment of a Cumulative Fire Fund under the provisions of Indiana Code 36-8-14 for the purposes as follows:

“For all uses as set out in Indiana Code 36-8-14-2”.

The tax will be levied on all taxable real and personal property within the taxing district and will not exceed \$0.0333 per \$100 of assessed valuation. The proposed fund will be levied beginning with taxes due and payable in the year 2020. Taxpayers appearing at such hearing shall have the right to be heard thereon. The proposal for re-establishment of the Cumulative Fire Development Fund is subject to approval by the Department of Local Government Finance, which will require a Notice of Submission to be given to the taxpayers by publication. Within thirty 30 days after the date of the adoption of the Cumulative Fire Fund by the Pleasant Township Trustee Board, the Trustee Office will publish a Notice of Adoption.

Upon publication of the Notice of Submission, ten (10) or more taxpayers in the taxing district may file a petition with the County Auditor not later than noon, thirty (30) days after publication of the Notice of Adoption setting forth their objections to the proposed fund (levy).
