

## Notice of Public Hearing

On or about May 1, 2018, the Town of Burns Harbor Redevelopment Commission (RDC) intends to apply to the Indiana Department of Natural Resources for a grant from the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) to support the Burns Harbor Marquette Greenway Town Center Connector Project. The RTP program is funded by Federal Highway Trust Fund received through the State of Indiana's share of the Fixing America's Surface Transportation as a set aside of the Transportation Alternatives Program.

The Burns Harbor Marquette Greenway Town Center Connector Project will include land acquisition and Trail construction along a three-quarter of a mile segment from the Meadowbrook Drive area south to the former Westport Community Center site. This project is not located in a floodplain. The RTP would fund 80% of the project costs up to \$200,000. The RDC would be responsible for 20% or \$50,000 in local match funds and any project costs above these minimum grant requirements.

The Burns Harbor RDC will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 24, 2018, 6pm at the Town Hall, 1240 Boo Road, Burns Harbor, IN 46304 to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed project.
