

NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF HEARING ON
PROPOSED RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF
CUMULATIVE CAPITAL
DEVELOPMENT FUND

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of the Town of Chesterton, Porter County, Indiana, that the Town of Chesterton Town Council will meet and conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on the 27th day of June, 2016 at the Chesterton Town Hall, 726 Broadway, Chesterton, Indiana on a Resolution for the re-establishment of a Cumulative Capital Development Fund under the provisions of Indiana Code §36-9-15.5, et seq, for all purposes set forth in I.C. §36-9-15.5-2. The tax will be levied on all taxable real and personal property within the taxing district and will not exceed \$0.04 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation. The proposed re-established fund will be levied beginning in 2016, payable 2017, continuing until reduced or rescinded. The Resolution for re-establishment of the Town of Chesterton Cumulative Capital Development Fund is subject to approval by the Department of Local Government Finance. Within 30 days after the date of the adoption of the cumulative fund, the Town of Chesterton will publish a Notice of Adoption. Upon the publication of the Notice of Adoption, fifty (50) or more taxpayers in the taxing district may file a petition with the County Auditor not later than noon thirty (30) days after publication of the Notice of Adoption, setting forth their objections to the proposed fund.
