COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS: SECTION ONE: Section 24-203 of the Chesterton Town Code shall be amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY OR-DAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHESTERTON, PORTER

The Town shall collect rates and charges from users of the storm water system, which rates and charges shall be payable as hereinafter provided and shall be in an amount, per calendar month, determined as follows: User Class Base Rate Variable Rate Total A. Residential \$4.65 \$2.18

B. Non-Residential \$4.65 \$2.18 per ERU Non-Residential Users with less than 3,585 square feet of impervious surface area will be billed at a rate of one (1) ERU. For Non-Residential Users, calculations of the ERU will be rounded to the nearest whole number. SECTION TWO: The rates and charges contained in this ordinance shall be in full force and

effect from and after August 9, 2016, after the adoption and publication of this Ordinance as required by law. ALL OF WHICH IS PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Chesterton Town Council this 25th day of July, 2016. CHESTERTON TOWN COUNCIL
