NICTD's overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goal is nine and 78/100 percent (9.78) of the proposal price. Proposers are required to make good faith efforts to meet or exceed the District's goal.

NICTD reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and/or waive minor discrepancies, omissions, variances or irregularities in any proposal, provided it is in the District's best interest to do so. No proposal can be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the proposals are opened.
