

NOTICE TO ALL PERSONS AFFECTED
OF ADOPTION AND CONTENT OF A
DECLARATORY RESOLUTION OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT & STORM
WATER MANAGEMENT OF PORTER
COUNTY, INDIANA, AND NOTICE OF
PUBLIC HEARING ON RESOLUTION

Taxpayers of the Department of Development & Storm Water Management of Porter County, Indiana (the "District"), and all other persons affected are hereby notified that the Storm Water Management Board of the District (the "Board"), at a meeting held on August 15, 2017, adopted its Declaratory Resolution, preliminarily finding that it will be of public utility and benefit to the citizens of the District to acquire, construct, rebuild, repair, extend, and improve the storm water system and equipment, and structures and equipment appurtenant to it (the "Projects"). Notice is further given that reports, the general plans, specifications and estimated costs have been prepared and, along with the Declaratory Resolution, are now on file and may be inspected in the County Administration Center, 155 Indiana Avenue, Valparaiso, Indiana. The estimated cost of the Projects, including all necessary and incidental expenses of the Projects and the issuance and sale of bonds in connection therewith, is not to exceed \$20,000,000.

Notice is further given that the Board will meet on September 19, 2017, at the hour of 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioner's Room in the County Administration Center, 155 Indiana Avenue, Valparaiso, Indiana, to conduct a public hearing at which it will receive and hear remonstrances from persons interested in or affected by such proceedings and will determine the public utility and benefit of the Projects. At the time fixed for hearing or at any time prior thereto any person owning real or personal property located within the District or any owner of land to be injuriously affected under the Declaratory Resolution may file a written remonstrance with the Board. At such hearing, which may be adjourned from time to time, the Board will hear all persons interested in the proceedings and all remonstrances that have been filed. After considering this evidence, the Board will take final action determining the public utility and benefit of the proposed Projects by either confirming, modifying, or rescinding the Declaratory Resolution.
