

**REQUEST FOR BIDDERS
DOUBLE TRACK DEMOLITION**

The Northern Indiana Commuter Transportation District (NICTD) is seeking sealed bids from qualified contractors to perform demolition services for the Double Track project as further described in the Bid Packet.

All bids must meet NICTD's specifications as further described in the Technical Specifications in the Bid Packet. Each qualified contractor may bid on one or multiple demolition packages contained within this Bid Packet.

Bids shall be submitted in a sealed opaque envelope clearly marked "Double Track Demolition – Package 1, 2 or 3". If Bidders are submitting on multiple packages, please ensure each bid is in its own envelope that clearly identifies the bid being submitted. All bids are to be submitted within an outer envelope. Bids shall be submitted on forms contained in each bid package.

Bids will be received not later than **2:30 P.M., local time, Thursday, October 22, 2020** at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the above stated time and date will be returned to the sender unopened. Bids must set forth full, accurate and complete information as required by the instructions in the bid packages. Failure to do so may result in rejection of a bid.

NICTD's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goal for these projects is twenty percent (20%) of the bid price. Bidders are required to make good faith efforts to meet or exceed the District's goal.

NICTD will award the Contracts to the lowest responsive and responsible bidders. NICTD reserves the right to reject any and all bids and waive technical defects if, in its judgment, the interests of NICTD so require. NICTD reserves the right to accept any bids within 60 days after the time of the opening of the bids, during which time no bid shall be withdrawn.
