ORDINANCE NO. 17-16 PORTER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NON-REVERTING FUND #8300 FOR RECEIPT OF INDIANA ARTS COMMISSION GRANT FOR THE PORTER COUNT MEMORIAL OPERA HOUSE WHEREAS, the Porter County Board of Commissioners adopted the Porter County Municipal Code on Tuesday, December 2, 1997 pursuant to Ordinance No. 97-38; and WHEREAS, the Porter County Board of Commissioners have deemed it necessary to pass a new ordinance for inclusion in the Porter County Municipal Code; and WHEREAS, I.C. 36-1-3-2 grants the Board of County Commissioners all County Commissioners all the powers that they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs; and WHEREAS, I.C. 36-1-3-6 states that if there is no constitutional or statutory provision requiring a specific manner for exercising a power, the Board of County Commissioners may adopt an ordinance prescribing a specific manner for exercising a power; and
WHEREAS, the Porter County Board of Commissioners have deemed it necessary for the effective operation of government as to local affairs to establish a special fund for the deposit rial to establish a special fail to the deposit of grants received by the Porter County Memo-rial Opera House, entitled "Memorial Opera House-Indiana Arts Commission Grant Fund"; NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS FILEDED ORDAINED THAT:

1. Title 3, Revenue and Finance in the Porter County Municipal Code is hereby amended through the addition of Chapter 3.097 entitled Ordinance Establishing Memorial Opera House-Indiana Arts Commission Grant Fund 2. That Section 3.097.010 is added to the Porter County Municipal Code to read as follows: 3.097.010 Fund Established The Board of Commissioners have determined that a need exists for the creation of a fund for deposit of grants for the Porter County Memorial Opera House.

That Section 3.097.020 Use of Revenue. nue is added to the Porter County Municipal Code to read as follows: 3.097.020 Use of Revenue The funds received and deposited in the Memorial Opera House-Indiana Arts Commission Grant Fund can be used only for the specific purposes set forth in this chapter. The funds received and deposited in the Memorial Opera House-Indiana Arts Commission Grant Fund shall be expended exclusively for the expenses related to the Porter County Memorial Opera louse as approved. The funds deposited in Memorial Opera House-Indiana Arts Commission Grant Fund are subject to appropriation by the Porter County Council.
4. That Section 3.097.030 Termination of Fund, Transfer of Funds is added to the Porter County Municipal Code to read as follows: 3.097.030 Termination of Funds, 3.097.030 Transfer of Funds The Memorial Opera House-Indiana Arts Commission Grant Fund is a non-reverting fund and shall remain in existence and remain perpetual in its terms until amended or terminated by sub-sequent ordinance enacted by the Porter County Board of Commissioners. If and when a subsequent ordinance is passed to terminate the life of this fund, the balance existing, if not otherwise provided for by ordinance shall revert to the Porter County General Fund.
