

## LEGAL NOTICE

The Board of Directors of the Grand Oaks Conservancy District is inviting potential candidates for membership on the Board of Directors of the Conservancy District to file nominating petitions pursuant to Ind. Code §14-33-5-3. Two (2) at-large directorship positions will be voted upon at the election of the Grand Oaks Conservancy District set for Thursday, February 21, 2019. The at-large directorship positions are currently held by Elizabeth A. Melvick and Robert L. Smith.

If there is a contested election, the directorship position(s) will be voted upon at the February 21, 2019, election of the Grand Oaks Conservancy District. Elizabeth A. Melvick's position is for a four (4) year term expiring in 2023. Robert L. Smith's position is for a one (1) year term expiring in 2020.

All candidates for the directorship position must be freeholders within the boundaries of the District and must also qualify by knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to the development of the Conservancy District. A candidate may be a nominee of a corporate freeholder. Anyone interested in seeking this position must file a nominating petition signed by at least five (5) freeholders. To be valid nominating petitions must be submitted to the Conservancy District Office in writing before December 1, 2018. Nominations that are mailed are valid if delivered or postmarked before December 1, 2018, if the envelope has sufficient U.S. Postage and is addressed to the Conservancy District Office, namely: Grand Oaks Conservancy District, c/o Ethan S.
