

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Porter Town Council will hold a public hearing at Porter Town Hall 303 Franklin Street, on the 27th day of October, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., on the Petitions of Russell and Susan Brandstetter requesting approval of the vacation of various public rights of way in Porter Beach. Descriptions of the public rights of way proposed to be vacated are as follows:

1. A portion of the alley located between State Street and Wabash Street and adjacent to Lots 3 through 8 and Lots 43 through 48 in Block 30.
2. The east half of Lakewood Drive adjacent to Lots 26 through 32 in Block 30.
3. The east half of State Street north of Roskin Road and adjacent to Lots 26 through 30 in Block 30, and the west half of State Street north of Roskin Road adjacent to Lots 20 and 21 in Block 31.
4. The east half of State Street south of Bote Drive adjacent to Lots 43 through 50 in Block 30, and the west half of State Street south of Bote Drive adjacent to Lots 1, 2 and 8, in Block 31.
5. The east half of State Street adjacent to Lots 38 through 41 in Block 25, and the west half of State Street adjacent to Lots 8 through 12 in Block 24.
6. A portion of the alley between State Street and Dearborn Street adjacent to Lots 11, 12, 39 and 40 in Block 30.

Copies of the Petitions are on file at the Office of the Porter Clerk-Treasurer, 303 Franklin Street, Porter, Indiana, for examination by the public before the public hearing. At the hearing, any person aggrieved by the proposed vacations may object to them as provided by I.C. § 36-7-3-13. Written objections to the Petitions that are filed with the Clerk-Treasurer's Office prior to the hearing will also be considered.
