

REQUEST FOR BIDDERS
DOUBLE TRACK DEMOLITION

The Northern Indiana Commuter Transportation District (NICTD) is seeking sealed bids from qualified contractors to perform demolition services for the Double Track project as further described in the Bid Packet.

All bids must meet NICTD's specifications as further described in the Technical Specifications in the Bid Packet. Each qualified contractor may bid on one or both demolition packages contained within this Bid Packet.

The Bid Packet, including the specifications, are available online at www.nictdplanroom.com. Bidders are encouraged to access this site to retrieve the bid packet, updated bid information and addendums.

Information regarding these Bids, including the results, can be found at mysouthshoreline.com. (Go to "About" then "Purchasing")

Bids shall be submitted electronically using the NICTD Plan Room submission link, located at the top left of the Project Information page. Bids shall be submitted in a ZIP folder, with files clearly marked "Double Track Demolition – Package 1 or 2". If Bidders are submitting on both packages, please ensure each bid is its own file that clearly identifies the bid being submitted. Bids shall be submitted on forms contained in each bid package.

Bids will be received not later than 2:30 P.M., local time, Thursday, November 19, 2020. The "Submit Bid" link will be disabled after the above stated time and date, so be sure to allow enough time to upload the entire proposal prior to this time. NICTD is not responsible for proposals that failed to upload prior to the submission deadline. Proposals must set forth full, accurate and complete information as required by the instructions in the proposal package. Failure to do so may result in rejection of a proposal.

The bid opening will be held virtually. Information to participate in this meeting can be found within the bid packet.

NICTD's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goal for these projects is twenty percent (20%) of the bid price. Bidders are required to make good faith efforts to meet or exceed the District's goal.

NICTD will award the Contracts to the lowest responsive and responsible bidders. NICTD reserves the right to reject any and all bids and waive technical defects if, in its judgment, the interests of NICTD so require. NICTD reserves the right to accept any bids within 60 days after the time of the opening of the bids, during which time no bid shall be withdrawn.
