

ORDINANCE NO. 17-21  
PORTER COUNTY BOARD OF  
COMMISSIONERS

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A

NON-REVERTING FUND 4922 FOR RECEIPT  
OF EARNINGS OF THE PORTER COUNTY  
GOVERNMENT NONPROFIT CHARITABLE  
FOUNDATION INC.

WHEREAS, the Porter County Board of Com-  
missioners adopted the Porter County Muni-  
cipal Code on Tuesday, December 2, 1997 pur-  
suant to Ordinance No. 97-38; and

WHEREAS, the Porter County Board of Com-  
missioners has deemed it necessary to pass a  
new ordinance for inclusion in the Porter  
County Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-1-3-2 grants the Board of  
County Commissioners all the powers that they  
need for the effective operation of government  
as to local affairs; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-1-3-6 states that if there is  
no constitutional or statutory provision requiring  
a specific manner for exercising a power, the  
Board of County Commissioners may adopt an  
ordinance prescribing a specific manner for ex-  
ercising a power; and

WHEREAS, the Porter County Board of Com-  
missioners has deemed it necessary for the ef-  
fective operation of government as to local af-  
fairs to establish a special fund for the deposit  
of earnings of The Porter County Government  
Charitable Nonprofit Foundation, Inc, entitled  
"Foundation Budget Fund";

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY  
ORDAINED THAT:

1. Title 3, Revenue and Finance in the Porter  
County Municipal Code is hereby amended  
through the addition of Chapter 3.091 entitled  
Ordinance Establishing Foundation Budget  
Fund.

2. That Section 3.091.010 is added to the Por-  
ter County Municipal Code to read as follows:

3.091.010 Fund Established

The Board of Commissioners has determined  
that a need exists for the creation of a fund for  
deposit of earnings from the Porter County  
Government Charitable Nonprofit Foundation,  
Inc.

3. That Section 3.091.020 Use of Revenue is  
added to the Porter County Municipal Code to  
read as follows:

3.091.020 Use of Revenue

Funds received and deposited in the Founda-  
tion Budget Fund may only be used for the spe-  
cific purposes set forth in this chapter and in ac-  
cordance with Indiana law. Specifically, the  
Foundation Budget Fund may be designated to  
any purpose for which public funds may be ex-  
pended and upon the approval and agreement  
of the Porter County Government Charitable  
Nonprofit Foundation, Inc., and then appropria-  
tion by the Porter County Council.

The funds deposited in the are subject to appro-  
priation by the Porter County Council.

4. That Section 3.091.030 Termination of Fund,  
Transfer of Funds is added to the Porter County  
Municipal Code to read as follows:

3.091.030 Termination of Funds, Transfer of  
Funds

The Foundation Budget Fund is a non-reverting  
fund and shall remain in existence and remain  
perpetual in its terms until amended or termi-  
nated by subsequent ordinance enacted by the  
Porter County Board of Commissioners. If and  
when a subsequent ordinance is passed to ter-  
minate the life of this fund, the balance existing,  
if not otherwise provided for by ordinance shall  
revert to the Porter County General Fund.

This ordinance passed and adopted this 31st  
day of October, 2017.
