

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BEVERLY SHORES TOWN COUNCIL AMENDING PORTIONS OF THE TEXT OF THE TOWN CODE RELATING TO LICENSE FEES FOR PERSONS ENGAGED IN CERTAIN TRADES, BUSINESSES, OR PROFESSIONS

WHEREAS, the Town of Beverly Shores ("Town") requires persons engaged in certain trades, businesses, or professions to apply for and receive a license in order to carry on business in the corporate limits of the Town; and WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to revise the fee schedule for business licensing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Beverly Shores Town Council as follows:

SECTION 1: That subsection 10.99(B) Section No. 110.01 of the Town Code, shall be amended and hereafter read as follows:

110.11 Licenses to engage in certain trade \$100

SECTION 2: That section 110.09 of the Town Code shall be amended, and that two new sentences shall be added to that section to read as follows:

Further, the provisions of this chapter shall not apply to any business, occupation, or profession which is operated by a resident in their primary residence. If a business required to obtain a license has more than one location in Town the business only needs to apply for one license.

SECTION 3: That section 110.11 of the Town Code shall be added as a new section and hereafter read as follows:

§ 110.11 FEE.

The fee shall be in accordance with the Town Fee Schedule, § 10.99.

SECTION 4: That section 110.12 of the Town Code shall be added as a new section and hereafter read as follows:

§ 110.12 PENALTY.

Any person violating any provision of this chapter for which no specific penalty is prescribed shall be subject to the fine provisions in §§ 10.97 and 10.98.

SECTION 5: That section 111.06 of the Town Code shall be amended and hereafter read as follows:

§ 111.06 TERM OF LICENSE.

Licenses issued under this chapter shall be valid for up to nine (9) months from the date of issuance, but shall expire no later than December 31 of the calendar year in which the license is valid. However, at any time after December 14, licenses may be issued that are valid for the ensuing calendar year.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption, and publication as provided by law.
