

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
TOWN OF BURNS HARBOR, IN
2017 GRANT PAVING PROJECT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town Council of Burns Harbor will receive sealed bids for the construction of the 2017 Grant Paving Project until 3:30 P.M. CST, Tuesday, January 10, 2017 at the Clerk-Treasurer's office, 1240 North Boo Road, Burns Harbor, Indiana 46304. Bids will be opened immediately following the submission deadline in the Town Hall room adjacent to the Clerk-Treasurer's office.

Project will be constructed in three (3) contract divisions, defined as follows:

1. HMA milling, paving, patching, and markings on Westport Rd (0.30 miles)
2. HMA milling, paving, patching, and markings on North Salt Creek Rd (0.20 miles)
3. HMA milling, paving, patching, and markings on Navajo Tr (0.17 miles)

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or acceptable bidder's bond made payable to the OWNER, in a sum of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid amount.

Proposals shall be properly and completely executed on Indiana Form 96, included in the Specifications.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids or parts thereof, waive all informalities, or irregularities in bidding and to re-advertise.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the Project shall apply to the Project throughout.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the Project site and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Contract Documents, Specifications and Drawings. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to its Bid.
