

LEGAL NOTICE

The Board of Directors of the Falling Waters Conservancy District is inviting potential candidates for membership on the Board of Directors of the Conservancy District to file nominating petitions pursuant to I.C. 14-33-5-3. All members of the Board of Directors of the Falling Waters Conservancy District serve on an at-large position. Two directorship positions will stand for election at the annual meeting of the Conservancy District in 2013. One of the at-large directorship positions is currently held by Incumbent Board Member Pete Kovacik and will be elected to a full four year term on the Board of Directors. The other at-large directorship position is currently vacant and will be elected for the three years remaining on the unexpired term resulting from the death of Incumbent Board Member Dr. Peter Gutierrez.

Any candidate for either of the at-large positions on the Board of Directors of the Conservancy District must be a freeholder within the boundaries of the Falling Waters Conservancy District and must also qualify by knowledge and experience pertaining to the development of the Conservancy District. The candidate may also be a nominee of a corporate freeholder.

Anyone interested in seeking either of the directorship positions must file a nominating petition signed by at least five (5) freeholders from the Conservancy District. The nominating petition must be filed prior to December 1, 2012 and can be mailed to the offices of the Conservancy District Attorneys: Falling Waters Conservancy District, PO BOX 164, Crown Point, Indiana 46308 Nominating petitions will be accepted if they are postmarked before December 1, 2012 if the envelope has sufficient United States postage and is addressed to the Conservancy District Post Office Box.
