

LEGAL NOTICE

The Board of Directors of the Grand Oaks Conservancy District invites potential candidates for membership on the Board of Directors of the Conservancy District to file nominating petitions pursuant to Ind. Code §14-33-5-3. One (1) directorship position will be elected at the Grand Oaks Conservancy District annual meeting in February 2013. This directorship position is an at-large position serving all of the Grand Oaks Conservancy District. This at-large directorship position is currently held by incumbent board member Stephen J. Melvick and will be elected to a full four year term.

Candidates for this at-large position on the Board of Directors of the Grand Oaks Conservancy District must be freeholder within the boundaries of the Grand Oaks Conservancy District and must also qualify by knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to the development of the Conservancy District. A candidate may also be a nominee of a corporate freeholder.

Anyone interested in seeking this at-large directorship position must file a nominating petition signed by at least five (5) freeholders from the Grand Oaks Conservancy District. Any nominating petition must be filed by delivering it to the offices of the Conservancy District located at 324 W. Division Rd., Valparaiso, IN. 46385 or the nominating petition may be mailed to the same address. If the nominating petition is hand delivered to the offices of the Conservancy District, it must be so delivered prior to December 1, 2012. Nominating petitions that are mailed are valid if they are delivered or postmarked (private postage meter postmarks will not be accepted) before December 1, 2012, if the envelope has sufficient United States Postage and is addressed to the offices of the Grand Oaks Conservancy District.
