

LEGAL NOTICE

The Board of Directors of the Nature Works Conservancy District invites potential candidates for membership on the Board of Directors of the Conservancy District to file nominating petitions pursuant to I.C. 14-33-5-3. One Directorship position will be elected at the Nature Works Conservancy District annual meeting in February, 2013. This directorship position is an at-large position serving all of the Aberdeen planned unit development. This at-large Directorship position is currently held by incumbent board member Dennis Hain and will be elected to a full four year term.

Candidates for this at-large position on the Board of Directors of the Nature Works Conservancy District must be a freeholder within the boundaries of the Aberdeen plan unit development and must also qualify by knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to the development of the Conservancy District. A candidate may also be a nominee of a corporate freeholder.

Anyone interested in seeking this at-large directorship position must file a nominating petition signed by at least five (5) freeholders from within the Aberdeen plan unit development. Any nominating petition must be filed by delivering it to the offices of the Conservancy District Financial Clerk located at 3408 Enterprise Avenue, Valparaiso, Indiana 46383, or the nominating petition may be mailed to the same address. If the nominating petition is hand delivered to the offices of Conservancy District Financial Clerk, it must be so delivered prior to December 1, 2012. Nominating petitions that are mailed are valid if they are delivered or postmarked (private postage meter postmarks will not be accepted) before December 1, 2012 if the envelope has sufficient United States Postage and is addressed to the offices of the Financial Clerk of the Nature Works Conservancy District.
