

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PORTER, INDIANA AMENDING CHAPTER 66, ARTICLE 7, SECTION 66-295 OF THE PORTER TOWN CODE

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Porter, Indiana as follows:

Section 1. Section 66-295(b) of the Town of Porter Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Porter shall sell said annual permits at the Town Hall at the following rates:

(1) All senior citizen residents sixty (60) years of age or older at time of purchase \$ 5.00 per year

(2) Town of Porter residents \$25.00 per year
Town employees \$15.00 per year

(3) Indiana, resident \$50.00 per year

(4) Out of state \$85.00 per year

(5) Smelt Parking Permit (March 1st through May 31st only)

a. Indiana \$15.00 per year

b. Out of state \$35.00 per year

As proof of residency, resident shall provide a valid Indiana driver's license and vehicle registration showing current legal address within the Town of Porter. Providing a mailing address in Porter is not sufficient. The Porter address must appear on both the license and registration.

Section 2. A new Subsection (d) shall be added to Section 66-295 which shall read as follows:

(d) A person who purchases a different car after obtaining a permit may transfer the permit to the new vehicle by providing the Clerk-Treasurer's Office with a copy of the new vehicle registration and the current permit. Pending receipt of the vehicle registration, a permit holder shall bring a Bill of Sale and Application for Title to the Clerk-Treasurer's Office. The permit shall not be considered to be validly transferred until the documents required by this Subsection have been provided to the Clerk-Treasurer's Office. If a permit is lost, it must be replaced with a new permit. A person may purchase a replacement permit at the applicable rate, if permits are still available.

Section 3. All other provisions of Section 66-295 shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Conflicting Ordinances. Any Ordinance or provision of any Ordinance of the Town of Porter Code of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
