

ORDINANCE NO. 13-01

Porter County Board of Commissioners

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 12-19

An ordinance establishing a

Porter County Redevelopment Commission

WHEREAS, the Porter County Board of Commissioners adopted the Porter County Code on Tuesday, December 2, 1997 pursuant to Ordinance No. 97-38; and

WHEREAS, the Porter County Board of Commissioners has deemed it necessary to amend the ordinance currently in the Porter County Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-1-3-2 grants the Board of County Commissioners all the powers that they need for the effective operation of government and to local affairs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-7-14 and I.C. 36-7-25 the Porter County Board of Commissioners previously established a Department of Redevelopment to be controlled by a Redevelopment Commission consisting of five (5) members and one (1) non-voting member.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED THAT:

1. Chapter 2.62.030 (Membership) is amended in the Porter County Code to read as follows:

2.62.030 Membership

The Porter County Department of Redevelopment will be controlled by a board of five (5) members to be known as the Porter County Redevelopment Commission. Three (3) members shall be appointed by the Porter County Board of Commissioners; one (1) shall be the President of the Board of Commissioners or his/her designee and two (2) citizen appointments. And two (2) members from the Porter County Council; one (1) member shall be the President of the Council or his/her designee and one (1) citizen member.

If a designee is appointed in lieu of a President of the Board of Commissioners or Council, a specific individual shall be appointed without proxy or substituted attendance and serve as the identified member of the Commission for the term of the appointment unless a vacancy occurs or until a successor is appointed in accord with I.C. 37-7-14-7.

The citizen appointees must be individuals who reside in Porter County and who do not otherwise hold elected office in the County.

In addition, the Porter County Board of Commissioners shall appoint one (1) advisory member from the board of school corporations whose boundaries extend into the unincorporated areas of Porter County.

2. That Section 2.62.040 is added to the Porter County Municipal Code to read as follows:

2.62.040 Repeal of other ordinances

Through the passage of this ordinance, Ordinance 09-02 and Ordinance 10-03 are hereby repealed in their entirety.
