ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 12 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CHESTERTON, PORTER COUNTY, INDIANA AMENDING ITS TOWN CODE CONCERNING RATES AND CHARGES TO BE COLLECTED BY THE TOWN FROM THE OWNERS OF PROPERTY SERVED BY THE TOWN'S SEWAGE WORKS

WHEREAS, the Town of Chesterton owns and operates sewage works for the purpose of collecting and disposing of sanitary sewage in an appropriate manner; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chesterton has previously established rates and charges to be collected by the Town from the owners of property

served by the Town's sewage works in accordance with Indiana Code 36-9-23-25(a); and WHEREAS, Section 25-87 of the Chesterton Town Code provides that the Town shall cause a study to be made every two years of the rates and charges for sewage services for the purposes of reviewing the fairness, equity and proportionality of the rates and charges for sewage

services; and that the Town shall upon completion of said study, revise and adjust the rates and charges, as necessary, in order to maintain the proportionality and sufficiency of the rates; and

WHEREAS, the Chesterton Utility Service Board has caused a study of the rates and charges in accordance with the Town Code and has recommended the adoption of the rates and charges contained in this Ordinance; and WHEREAS, legal notice has been given and a public hearing has been conducted, all as required by law, concerning the changes contained in this Ordinance; and WHEREAS, the Chesterton Town Council, hav-

ing studied the matter and given consideration to the factors contained in I.C. 36-9-23-25, now finds it necessary to amend previously established rates and charges to be collected by the Town for services rendered by its sewage works.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Chesterton Town Council as follows:

SECTION 1: That effective January 1, 2013, Section 25-83(A) and Section 25-83(B)of the Chesterton Town Code shall be amended and hereafter read as follows:

A. The sewage rates and charges shall be based on the quantity of water used on or in the property or premises subject to such rates and charges as the same is measured by the water meter there in use, plus a base charge based on the size of water meter installed except as herein otherwise provided. For the purpose of billing and collecting the charges for sewage service, the water meters shall be read bi-monthly and the users shall be billed bi-monthly (or period equaling two months). The water usage schedule is as follows:

- A. Additional charges, for treating stronger-than-normal domestic waste shall be made on the following basis:
- 1. Rate surcharges based on suspended solids. There shall be an additional charge of twenty-eight cents (\$0.28) per pound of suspended solids for suspended solids received in excess of two hundred (200) milligrams per liter of fluid.
- 2. Rate surcharges based on BOD. There shall be an additional charge of twenty-eight cents (\$0.28) per pound of biochemical oxygen demand for BOD received in excess of two hundred (200) milligrams per liter of fluid.
- 3. Rate surcharges based upon ammonia. There shall be an additional charge of one dollar fourteen cents (\$1.14) per pound of ammonia for ammonia received in excess of thirty (30) milligrams per liter of fluid.

 4. Rate surcharges based upon phosphorus.
- 4. Rate surcharges based upon phosphorus. There shall be an additional charge of one dolar fourteen cents (\$1.14) per pound of phosphorus for phosphorus received in excess of ten (10) milligrams per liter of fluid.
- SECTION 3: That effective January 1, 2013, Section 25-88(B) of the Chesterton Town Code shall be amended and hereafter read as follows:
- B. The fee for a single-family connection to the Town's sanitary sewer system shall be determined as follows:

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on January 1, 2013, after its adoption and publication as required by law.
