TOWN OF PORTER, IN  
TRIANGLE LIFT STATION AND FORCE  
MAIN UPGRADE PROJECT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Porter hereinafter referred to as the OWNER, will receive sealed bids for the construction of the Triangle Lift Station and Force Main Upgrade Project.

Sealed bids are invited and may be delivered or forwarded by registered mail, addressed to:

Town of Porter, Attn: Carol Pomeroy, Clerk-Treasurer, 303 Franklin Street, Porter, IN 46304.

Sealed bids must be submitted prior to 4:00 P.M. (local time) on February 19, 2013. Proposals received after such time will be returned unopened. Bids will be opened in the Town Council public meeting on February 19, 2013. The Project will be constructed in one (1) contract division and is defined and outlined as follows:

This project generally includes the upgrade upgrade of the existing sewer lift station at E. Triangle Street and N. Triangle St., including new wet well and valve vault, pumps, backup power, controls, and telemetry. The project includes the installation of approximately 2,900 feet of new 8-in HDPE sewer force main from the new lift station to an existing manhole on Waverly Rd just south of Summertree Dr.

Requests for Contract Documents, Specifications and Drawings must also include a return street address; post office box numbers are not acceptable. Partial sets of Contract Documents, Specifications and Drawings are not available. Copies of any and all addenda which may be issued for this Project shall be included with the purchased documents and shall be forwarded to all Plan and Specification holders. A prebid meeting will be held at the Town Hall, 303 Franklin St, Porter, IN on Tues February 5th, 2013, at 2:00 P.M. (Local Time). All prime contractors, subcontractors, vendors and suppliers and other interested parties are invited to attend.

No refunds will be issued for this Project.

Approved performance and payment bonds guaranteeing faithful and proper performance of the work and materials, to be executed by an acceptable surety company, will be required of the Contractor at the time he executes his contract. The bonds will be in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price.

Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the title of the Project and the name and address of the Bidder. All bids must be submitted on the bid forms as identified in the Contract Documents, Specifications and Drawings.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or acceptable bidder's bond made payable to the OWNER, in a sum of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the highest aggregate bid.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any bid, or all bids, or to accept any bid or bids, or to make such combination of bids as may seem desirable, and to waive any and all informalities in bidding. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. NO bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least sixty (60)

time for receipt of bids for at least sixty (60) days.

A conditional or qualified Bid will not be accepted. Award will be made to the low, responsive, responsible bidder.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the Project shall apply to the Project throughout.

Proposals shall be properly and completely executed on Indiana Form 96, included in the Specifications. Proposals shall include all information requested by Indiana Form 96 (Revised, 2010). Under Section III of Form 96 the Bidder shall submit a financial statement. The OWNER may make such investigations as deemed necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform the work, and the Bidder shall furnish to the OWNER all such information and data for this purpose as the OWNER may request. The OWNER reserves the right to reject any Bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of such Bidder fails to satisfy the OWNER that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and to complete the work contemplated therein.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the Project site and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Contract Documents, Specifications and Drawings. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to its Bid.
