

LEGAL NOTICE

The Board of Directors of the Twin Creeks Conservancy District is inviting candidates for membership on the Board of Directors of the Conservancy District to file nominating petitions pursuant to I.C. 14-33-5-3. Two directorship positions will be voted upon at the 2013 annual meeting of the Twin Creeks Conservancy District. One of these directorship positions serves the Old South Haven Area, and is currently held by Incumbent Board Member Kathy Reber. The other directorship position serves the new South Haven Area and is currently held by Incumbent Board Member Nina Rivas. Both directorship positions will be elected to full four year terms on the Board of Directors.

Interested and qualified applicants for the either directorship position are invited to submit a nominating petition signed by at least five (5) freeholders from within their respective directorship areas. A candidate must be a freeholder from the directorship area for which the nominating petition is filed or the nominee of a corporate freeholder. The nominating petitions must be filed pursuant to the provisions of the Indiana Conservancy Act before December 1, 2012. Nominating petitions can be filed by mailing them to the mailing address of the Twin Creeks Conservancy District which is P.O. Box 111, Portage, Indiana 46368. Nominating petitions that are mailed are valid only if delivered or postmarked before December 1, 2012 and if the envelope has sufficient United States Postage and is addressed to the aforementioned address.

To be qualified to hold the position of director, an individual must be qualified by knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to the development of the district. A nominee need not be a petitioner for establishment of the district. A nominee does not have to be a resident of the area of the district from which nominations are invited but must be a freeholder.
