

## LEGAL NOTICE

The Board of Directors of the Valparaiso Lakes Area Conservancy District is inviting potential candidates for membership on the Board of Directors of the Conservancy District to file nominating petitions pursuant to I.C. 14-33-5-3. The directorship positions serving the Hillcrest Beach area, Blackhawk Beach area and the Burlington Beach North area will be voted upon at the calendar year 2013 annual meeting of the Valparaiso Lakes Area Conservancy District. The Hillcrest Beach area Directorship position is currently held by Incumbent Board Member Donald Kareiva. The Blackhawk Beach area Directorship Position is currently held by Incumbent Board Member Nancy Satterlee. The Burlington Beach North area Directorship Position is currently held by Incumbent Board Member Megan Summers. The Hillcrest area directorship position and the Burlington Beach North directorship position will each be elected for a full four year term on the Board of Directors. The Blackhawk Beach area directorship position will be elected for the two years remaining on the unexpired term to which Incumbent Nancy Satterlee was appointed. The positions serve the following geographical areas:

### District 1- Hillcrest Area

All of that part of the Valparaiso Lakes Area Conservancy District lying north of the south line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 1, Township 35 North, Range 6 West of the Second Principal Meridian in Porter County, Indiana (said line also being the north line of Lots 77, 78 and 79 in Kingsridge North Unit 1 and the extension of said north lines to the west) and lying west of the water channel connecting Long Lake and Flint Lake.

### District 3- Blackhawk Beach Area

All of that part of the Valparaiso Lakes Area Conservancy District lying east of East Long Lake Drive, Private Drive 2 (located approximately 100' east of East Long Lake Drive), and the east shore of Flint Lake and north of the centerline of Pumping Station Road (located approximately 680' south of Lakeview Road) and said Pumping Station Road extended.

### District 4 – Burlington Beach North Area

All that part of the Valparaiso Lakes Area Conservancy District lying north of Burlington Beach Road, south of Pumping Station Road (located approximately 680' south of Lakeview Road) and south shore of Flint Lake and east of the west line of the South One-Half of Section 6, Township 35 North, Range 5 West of the Second Principal Meridian in Porter County, Indiana.

Any candidate for either of the three directorship positions must be a freeholder within the boundaries of their respective directorship areas and must also qualify by knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to the development of the conservancy district. A candidate may also be a nominee of a corporate freeholder. Anyone interested in seeking any of the three directorship positions must file a nominating petition at the office of the Valparaiso Lakes Area Conservancy District located at 1805 Burlington Beach Road, Valparaiso, Indiana, before December 1, 2012. The petition must be signed by at least five (5) freeholders from the directorship area for which the nominee is seeking nomination. Nominating petitions that are mailed are valid if delivered or postmarked (private postage meter postmarks will not be accepted) before December 1, 2012 if the envelope has sufficient U.S. Postage and is addressed to the District's office.
